Subject: Campaign for Aadhaar enrolment of all the students eligible for different scholarship programme of the government.

Sir/Madam

As you are aware that out of total population of 128 Crore (Projected - 2015) Aadhaar has been generated for over 102 Crore residents covering 96 % adult population. However Aadhaar saturation in respect of children of age 5 -18 years is still low at 63.1 % respectively.

2. The Aadhaar (Targeted Delivery of Financial and Other Subsidies, Benefits and Services) Act, 2016 has been gazetted on 26th March 2016 and likely to come in force shortly. The Section 7 of the Act, provides that "the Central Government or, as the case may be, the State Government may, for the purpose of establishing identity of an individual as a condition for receipt of a subsidy benefit or service for which the expenditure is incurred from, or the receipt there from forms part of, the Consolidated Fund of India, require that such individual undergo authentication, or furnish proof of possession of Aadhaar number or in the case of an individual to whom no Aadhaar number has been assigned, such individual makes and application for enrolment".

3. During the meeting held on 9th May 2016, chaired by Hon'ble PM, it was, inter alia, decided that Aadhaar will be used as identifier for all centrally funded scholarship schemes so as to facilitate direct and timely transfer of scholarships and thereby avoid hardships to genuine and deserving students. Therefore it was decided to immediately launch a campaign for enrolment of scholarship beneficiaries. Further, in a meeting with Secretary, Department of School Education and Literacy on 11.7.2016, it was decided that based on recent strategies adopted by Rural Development Department for enrolment of MNREGS beneficiaries and Department of Pensions for pensioners, following strategies are recommended for enrolment of scholarship beneficiaries in the Schools;

4. The School Education Departments in States may undertake in a campaign mode the enrolment of all students for AADHAAR before 30 July 2016. The States need to take various actions as indicated below in order to ensure that no students willing to apply for scholarship are left behind due to non-availability of Aadhaar:-

- a) Identify school wise number and list of students eligible for any scholarship programme and availability of Aadhaar with them
- b) Each district will have to develop an appropriate mix of strategies for ensuring 100% coverage before 31 July 2016. This may include taking school children to nearest Permanent Enrolment Centre (PEC) or organizing special enrolment camps for schools/ cluster of schools with large uncovered students.

- c) In case number of students not having Aadhaar is less or PEC is nearby, these children will have to be taken to nearest PEC for their Aadhaar enrolment by the respective Head Master / Principal of the school. List and address of PECs is available on resident portal (<https://resident.uidai.net.in/>) on Locate Enrolment Centre tab).
 - d) In case students not having Aadhaar are large in number, enrolment camp in the school or for a cluster of schools may be organized.
 - e) In case of students who have enrolled for Aadhaar and have not received Aadhaar may download Aadhaar from resident portal (<https://resident.uidai.net.in/>). The facility to download the Aadhaar is also available in the PECs. In addition State officials and district collectors can be provided advance search facility to help children who have lost their EID/UID. UIDAI regional offices may be contacted by State officials/Collectors for creation of login for advance search.
 - f) It may be ensured that during Aadhaar enrolment mobile and email of either the student or his parent or any family member is captured. This will facilitate communication about Aadhaar generation, Download of e-Aadhaar, retrieval of Aadhaar Number etc through his mobile once his Aadhaar number is generated.
 - g) The district collector will prepare a mapping of schools and enrolment centers available in the district and also a roster for organizing enrolment camps wherever required. For preparation and monitoring, the district collector will have weekly coordination meetings with education official, official of social justice department, tribal department, and District Coordinator of CSCs and enrolment agencies empanelled by UIDAI.
 - h) In order to enable Aadhaar based payment of scholarship, the beneficiary bank account is required to be linked with his/her Aadhaar. Banks require written mandate of beneficiary for this purpose. A Sample Bank Seeding Form is attached, which may be signed by the beneficiary students and/or their parent/Guardian. The Head Master / Principal will submit all such forms to respective banks. Alternatively, by soliciting support from district administration, the bank consent forms can be given to the Lead District Manager (LDM) who will then distribute these forms to respective banks/ bank branches. Seeding of Aadhaar with bank account can be checked either at resident portal (<https://resident.uidai.net.in/>) or by using NPCI service by dialing *99*99#
5. A special cell may be created in State Education Department and each district to resolve any difficulty being faced by any school/collector during enrolment. State Education Secretary may also hold weekly VC/meeting with all District collectors, District Education officials, officials in charge of various scholarships, officials of CSC-SPV, Banks, Enrolment agencies, UIDAI at the state level. Chief Secretaries are requested to chair this meeting at least once in every fortnight.
6. You are requested to issue necessary instruction to the concerned departments handling various scholarship and district collectors for completing the Aadhaar enrolment student of age 5-18 years accordingly.
